“It took one month to do the entire project,” said Ulysses Leon. Alex Sanchez and Ulysses, both sophomores, who worked together and entered their project in the annual CJUSD Science Fair that took place on Feb. 4.

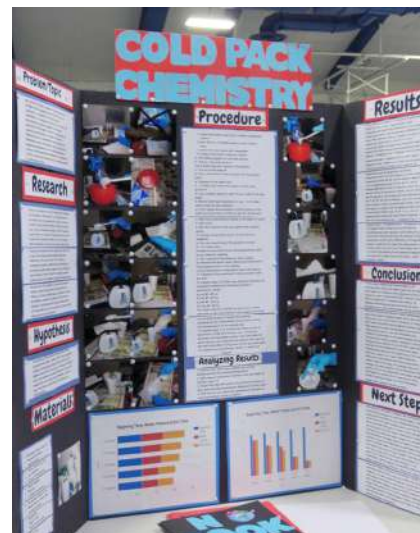
The science fair was hosted by BHS in the gym with over 100 exhibits that were displayed from all 28 schools in the district. Awards and medals were given out Feb. 6.

Alex and Ulysses’s project was titled, “The Effect of the Ratio

of the Potassium Nitrate to Sucrose in Creating a Rocket” and built their rocket with materials that added up to only \$5. “We saw a video of someone making a rocket out of potassium nitrate, and the science fair just happened to be right around the corner,” said Alex.

They were the Overall Sweepstakes Winner which means the project placed first in the district and they got to advance to SIMS, along with 35 others exhibits. SIMS is the Inland Science and Engineering Fair and was held on April 6. Along with taking first place, Alex and Ulysses also received a \$50 gift card to Barnes & Noble.

Ulysses entered because he wanted to see if he could do better than his peers. “I learned that if I put my mind to something challenging I can overcome it...even though I don’t necessarily like group work,” laughed Ulysses.



Other winners included: Samuel Rivera, Andrew Lopez and Mauricio Munoz who will also advance to SIMS. Their project was titled, “Ordinary Substances Against Fire.” Andrew said about their group project, “We took second place. Our project was about various kitchen products and which ones put out fire the best. Baking soda works best for a grease fire. We studied baking soda, sugar, water and flour.”

Youth leadership winner wants to go into politics

“Oh my gosh. Everyone who went, absolutely loved it,” smiled counselor Mrs. Heather Butterworth. The Hugh O’Brien Youth Leadership Foundation (HOBY), allows a student provided by their school to attend a three day seminar at Chapman University in Orange, California.

“Honestly, I knew I had a fair shot of getting in but I didn’t think I would actually win,” said winner Ulysses Leon. He took two hours to write his winning submission. “None of the clubs or sports here seem interesting to me and this caught my attention so I thought I would give it a shot and enter.”

HOBY’s goal is to inspire and develop our global community of youth to a life dedicated to leadership, service, and innovation. Oral and/or written communication skills, creative problem solving, and sensitivity to the needs or concerns of others are only some quali-

ties needed to get into the program. The Colton Woman’s Club, who organized all of it, ask for recommendations of students from teachers who they see as a potential leaders.

“Not many students submitted essays this time around,” said Mrs. Butterworth. In order to enter, students must write an essay that answers the questions that are given. From there, the Woman’s Club narrows it down to the top 10-15 students with the highest GPA, read the essays, and choose the student who they think will most benefit from the experience.

Ulysses wants to become a politician in the future. “I want to be able to help people later on life and I see politics as the best way to do that.”

Students who get in the program get the chance to get a taste of the, “College experience.” They stay in dorms on campus with

roommates from different schools. The program consists of unique leadership training, service learning, and motivation building experiences that will take place from 7AM-11PM for the three days that they are there.

“I’m not scared to go by myself, I know it’ll be a good experience.”

The Power of Language

Words are powerful for it will leave scars we cannot see which are the hardest to heal and that makes it greater than violence. I will rather choke on the greatness of my language than to

The power of language changes our percipience of the world and Chavez’s contributions to our society are remarkable for his ambitions we broad enough to include the aspirations and needs of others, for their sakes and for our own.

We can only be what we give ourselves the power to be. The victim can always become the victor if one chooses the dangerous liberty over the peaceful slavery. Chavez becomes the spokesperson for the oppressed because he was one himself too. His journey won monumental gains for farm workers, civil rights, political representation for racial minorities and environmental justice. Without Chavez having his voice heard, there will still be economic injustice, sexual, racial, and anti-immigrant discrimination.

We are drowning in information, but starving for knowledge. Violence has filled our nation and it does not benefit anybody, but at the center of nonviolence stands the principle of love. There is no path to peace because peace is the path.
