All Carver students will participate in a classroom science fair as part of our study of the scientific method and general science inquiry skills. Your student's science teacher will provide specific project directions and a grading rubric.

2019-2020 Science Fair Dates

All classroom Science Fairs will be held by **Friday, November 22nd**. Please refer to information from your student's science teacher for the specific date.

The top-scoring projects from each science class will advance to the school-wide science fair on **Friday, December 6th**. Visitors will be welcome to view projects on this date. A specific schedule will be sent home at a later time.

The three top-scoring projects from each grade level will be awarded. There will also be a variety of special awards, such as Best in Show, Most Creative, Mathematician Award, and Engineering Award.

The three top-scoring sixth-grade projects will advance to the Wiregrass Regional Science Fair hosted by the Alabama College of Osteopathic Medicine (ACOM) on **January 23, 2020**. The two top-scoring fifth-grade projects (one from each pod) and the highest scoring fourth-grade project will also advance to this fair.
