Dear Science Olympiad Coach,

Muscatel Middle School is excited to host its 5th Annual Science Olympiad Division B Invitational Tournament on **Saturday, January 16th, 2016**. Muscatel Middle School is in Rosemead, California, about 10 miles east of Downtown Los Angeles, in the San Gabriel Valley. This invitational tournament is an excellent way to prepare your team for the upcoming regional and state tournaments this school year.

The Muscatel Invitational is open to a maximum of 30 Division B teams. On a first come-first served basis, schools can request to have a second team entered (B team/ JV team). Muscatel will have two teams entered in the tournament. No more than six other schools can have two teams; only one team will be permitted for all remaining schools. Teams will only be considered officially-registered once the registration form, payment, AND insurance certificate are received. Each team is expected to set up and run one to two events, including writing the event test(s), bringing all the necessary equipment and materials for the event(s), scoring the event(s), etc. If less than 30 teams register for the invitational, some teams may need to set up and run two events.

All Division B competition events will be contested, with the exception of Elastic Launched Glider. Please rank your choice of events that you would like to run from 1st through 6th on the registration form. Events will be assigned, first come-first served, after a team becomes officially-registered. California State Tournament (South) trial events may be included to the Muscatel Invitational at a later date.

Medals will be awarded to the top 6 places for each event as well as trophies to the top 6 overall schools. Participation medals will also be given to each team member. The two Muscatel teams are eligible for event medals, but not for the top 6 overall trophies. At the end of competition day, each team will receive all of their students' tests along with electronic versions of the blank tests and answer keys for all events. To offset the cost of the awards, the hospitality room for coaches and volunteers, awards venue costs, as well as the custodial costs needed for the day, the registration fee is \$175.00 per team.

Please fill out the registration form and mail it back as soon as possible with a check payable to Muscatel ASB (Science Olympiad). Registration deadline is December 1st, 2015 OR as soon as we reach maximum capacity of 30 teams. We look forward to seeing you at the 2016 Muscatel Middle School Science Olympiad Invitational Tournament in Rosemead, CA.

5th ANNUAL MUSCATEL SCIENCE OLYMPIAD INVITATIONAL TOURNAMENT INSURANCE CERTIFICATE REQUIREMENT

Just like previous years, the Rosemead Elementary School District requires that your school district send us a Certificate of Proof of Insurance/Liability Coverage from your school district's insurance carrier. Per the Rosemead Elementary School District, no team can become officially-registered for the Muscatel Invitational Tournament without this certificate.

This is the same form that the California State Tournament (South) requires from each competing team at our state tournament. Please ask the risk management office of your school district to obtain this certificate for you from your school district's insurance carrier. This certificate needs to be mailed or emailed to Muscatel Middle School by your school district's insurance carrier before your team can be considered officially-registered.
