- One passport per participant.

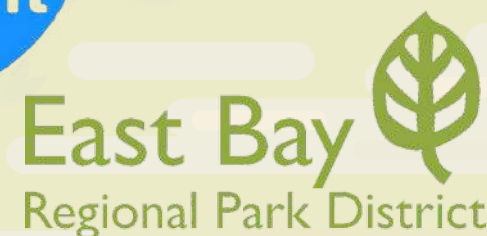

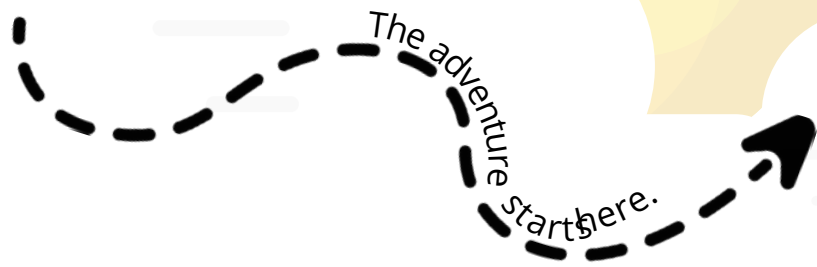

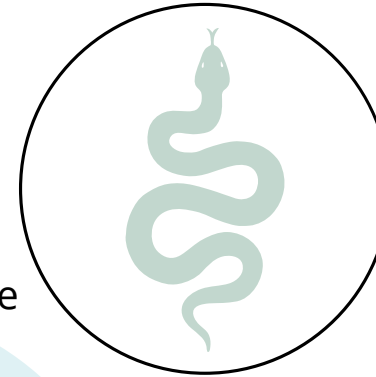

Are you ready, explorers?! Meet Python Ron and his Reptile Kingdom during this exciting event. Attendees will get up close and personal with these awesome creatures.

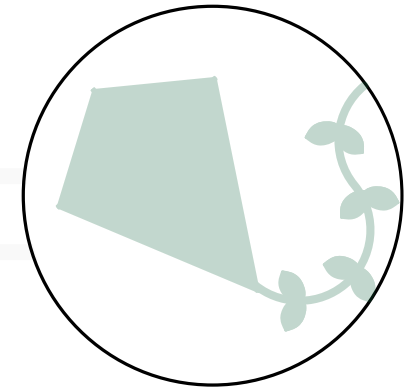

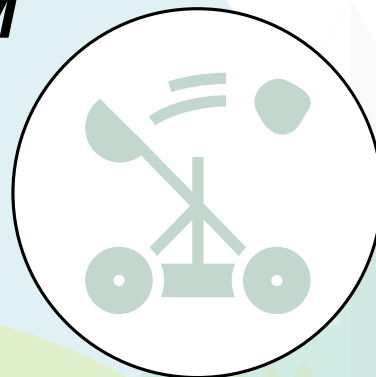

Catapults, how do they work? Join the Freedom STEAM as they show us how to make and use catapults!

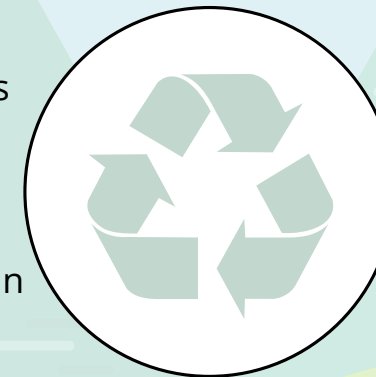
