Applicants must submit TWO (2) typewritten copies of the completed application form, together with any supporting materials, to the Foundation. We now have a rolling applications deadline process, therefore applications will be accepted at any time during the school year. The Foundation may require a personal interview with or additional information from the applicant. Input may be sought from the School Administration on all applications. Review of applications will occur in a timely manner after receipt of applications and successful applicants will be notified soon thereafter. The Foundation expects to formally announce Grant Awards at the Board of Education meeting in late May or early June. Grants must be expended within the semester or school year designated, or the remainder of the Grant will be returned to the Foundation.
