

SUMMARY OF SEEF GRANTS

2006 - 2007 GRANTS - FOUR GRANTS AWARDED FOR A TOTAL OF \$4,000:

Salmon Development and Resoration Project - This program entails the purchase of an incubation tank system, including the chiller and actual salmon eggs, for the purpose of “growing” the salmon in the classroom, and later, releasing them into the wild. Many opportunities of data collection, habitat study, measurements and calculations – both science and math, etc. (*David Palinkas, 6th grade, Squadron Line*)

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Spreading Schulwerk – Bringing ORFF to Simsbury – This grant allows for the updating of current, select instrumentarium. Basically, the purchase of new xylophones for classroom instruction, as well as music enrichment activities via school concerts, ensembles, community celebration concerts, etc. (*Chris Tranberg, Music Teacher, Squadron Line*)

Experiencing West African Culture, Rhythm, and Dance through the African Drumming Circle - This project brings the African Drum Circle into the classroom.
