#### FINAL EXAMS

Graduating seniors, along with Career Center students, will take final exams on 5/09/23 and 5/10/23. W.C.C.C/CMU finals will be from the  $15^{th}$  –  $18^{th}$  of May.

### **CLEARANCE FROM SCHOOL**

- Check with Mrs. Rubalcaba in the Budget and Accounting Office to see if anything is posted on your records (fines/fees).
- Check in the Library to clear fines and return books (all items are due April 28th).
- A final end of year check out sheet will be given to you for your final checkout from school. This must be completed in order to pick up your cap and gown. Please note: Early completers also need a final end of year check out sheet to be completed in order to pick up their cap and gown.
- The deadline for payment and final clearance is 11:30 a.m., Tuesday, May 16th. You MUST have clearance from the Budget Office.
  - o The last day to pay by **check** is on Friday, April 28th.
- Seniors not given final clearance may not receive their diploma at the ceremony if clearance is not met. The main office will have them available starting Friday, May 19th.
- Payment for cap and gown is to be paid to Jostens (242-5030). Caps/gowns may be picked up in the small gym on Friday, May 12<sup>th</sup>, from 9:00 11:30 a.m. after final check out.
- Caps and gowns will not be available before May 12th. Please do NOT ask for your caps and gowns
  early.

#### SPECIAL NOTES

- After checkout and senior activities, please do not return to campus except for graduation ceremonies or to take care of school business. Remember, underclassmen still have class. Please be considerate of others.
- LOCKER CLEANOUT: Please do not forget to clean out your locker. A fine will be assessed if the locker has been damaged or is not clean. Remove all pictures, decals, etc.
- Requests for final transcripts MUST be made through your Schoolinks account on or before the final checkout day, 5/12/23. This step is crucial, please do not delay as some colleges may put a registration hold on your account. THIS INCLUDES NCAA CLEARING HOUSE REQUESTS!
- ONLY THOSE STUDENTS WHO MEET GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED BY THE SCHOOL BOARD WILL BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN GRADUATION CEREMONIES. Lack of prior notification does not override the policy nor guarantee participation.

# Central High School Graduation Ceremony Class of 2023

Commencement ceremonies mark a portion of scholastic attainment culmination and are intended to be a memorable occasion. Remembering our role as dignified, mature young adults is the best way we can make the occasion truly impressive.

GOWNS: Gowns have been packed very tightly. DO NOT IRON, only steam or hang in a bathroom with hot water running. Please place the gown on a hanger after. The wearing of buttons, signs, etc., is prohibited.

CAPS: Caps are to be worn with the long point to the back of the head and the short point down on the forehead. The mortarboard should be in a horizontal position on the top of the head rather than on the back of the head. It is recommended that bobby pins be used to help hold the mortarboard in place. Any decorations added to the cap must be school appropriate. The tassel is worn on the left side until completion of Commencement. Gentlemen, please remove your caps for the playing of the National Anthem.

CLOTHING UNDER GOWNS: It is recommended that lightweight clothing be worn for the graduation ceremony since it may be hot on the athletic field. SHORTS AND/OR THONG SANDALS ARE NOT APPROPRIATE ATTIRE. IF YOU HAVE ANY QUESTIONS, TALK TO SELLDEN OR DOWNEY.


BOYS/GIRLS: Professional/Business attire is expected. Please do not wear heels as it will become difficult to walk on the field.

BE ON TIME FOR THE LINE-UP. It takes approximately 25 to 30 minutes to check and double-check the line-up procession.

BEHAVIOR FOR GRADUATION EXERCISES: Students identified as under the influence of alcohol or other drugs (other than by prescription) shall be banned from ceremonies. Law enforcement will be notified. Diplomas may be held if a student displays inappropriate behavior during the ceremony.

DURING THE CEREMONY: Remember that you are easily observed from the stands. Please refrain from talking as you arrive on the field.





Professional pictures will be taken during Commencement ceremonies. Seniors will have the opportunity to purchase photos online through M.J. Thomas.

Photographers and people with other recording devices will not be permitted inside the fence on the field before or during ceremonies. Please caution friends and relatives who want pictures or videos to remain behind the fence until ceremonies are completed.
