

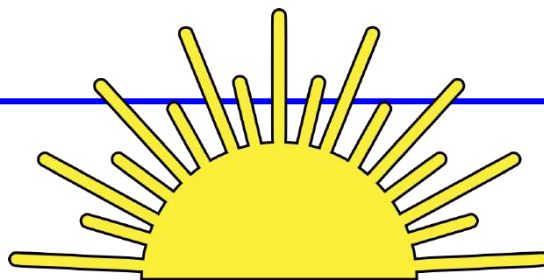

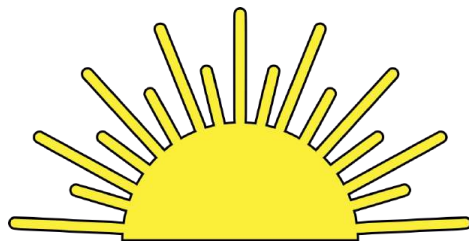

3. Pay in full online with a credit or debit card.

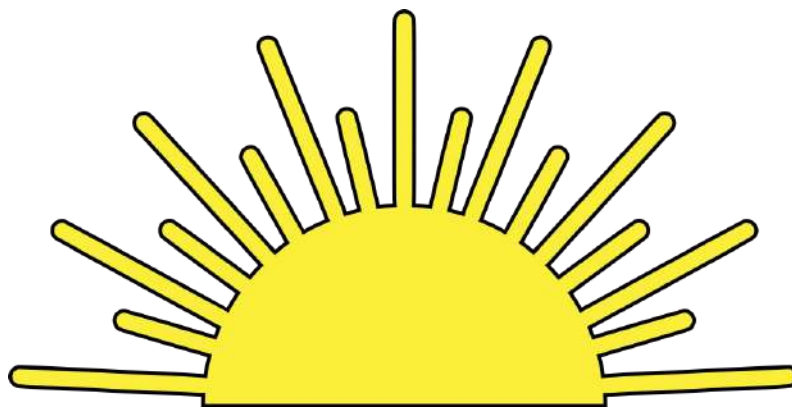
