

What is Child Find?

Child Find is a component of the Individuals with Disability Education Act (IDEA' 04) that requires Public Education Agencies (PEA) to locate, identify, and evaluate all children with disabilities, aged birth through 21, located within their boundaries of responsibility who are in need of early intervention or special education services.

When do we have Child Find Screenings?

Every 45 days our school hold Developmental Screenings for children birth to 5 years of age, whose legal guardian suspects a disability and who are not currently enrolled in a GUSD public school. The event will be on the school district campus and contact GUSD school to



I am writing to inform you of a schedule change for next week. On September 22nd - 23nd, all the students will be online/remote. Teachers will be working on their professional development at the various schools on the 22nd.

On the 23th GUSD busses will pick up only those students that have submitted a permission slip for the vaccination event. There will be 1 bus run in the monting and will follow the primary school am pick up time, for K-12 students both "A" and "B".

- · Students will be taken directly to Sage hospital for the flu vaccination event.
- . GUSD will be following CDC guidelines on the buses & all students and staff are required to wear a mask.
- · GUSD Staff and Security will be at the MFV event to monitor our students.
- Students will return home when finished at the event.
- · All students will stay in the same bus group.

If you choose not to participate in the mass flu vaccination event, we will not be picking up your child that day.

A back-to-school reminder:

Families who don't usually file a tax return may still qualify for advance Child Tax Credit payments.

MIRS irs.gov/childtaxcredit2021

The IRS is reaching out to America's school districts to help spread the word about the 2021 Advance Child Tax Credit payments, which could be to up to \$1,800 per qualifying child. These payments are made automatically to taxpayers who qualified on their 2020 tax returns. Our current outreach efforts are focused on low-income families who may not be required to file tax returns. We have developed a tool that can help these families get the Advanced Child Tax Credit payments and help them get missed Economic Impact Payments (EIP). This could amount to over \$14,000 for a family of 2 adults and 2 children who may be struggling to make ends meet. The clock is ticking to sign up because the Non-Filer Sign-Up tool or https://www.irs.gov/ credits-deductions/child-tax-credit-nonfiler-sign-up-tool will be closing on
