NOTE:

- Campaigning will only be necessary for incoming 8th graders running for an OFFICER POSITION
- Class representative positions for incoming 7th and 8th graders will be selected by the SGA sponsors.
- Eligibility for all SGA positions will be based upon the following:
 - Applications are complete and submitted in a timely fashion
 - Teacher recommendation

Homewood Middle School SGA: Campaign Guidelines

- All posters/banners/flyers must be approved by Mrs. Stanfield or Mrs. Miley before they
 are placed on the walls. You may bring posters to be approved at any time before
 campaigning starts, however, the last possible day to do so will be Friday, April 23rd.
- All campaign material must be removed from the walls by 3:30 pm on Friday, April 30th.
- Each candidate may use ONE banner, FOUR posters (standard size), and TEN flyers in his/her campaign.
- All materials must be hung with approved tape. All campaign material must be in good taste. Any negative or offensive slogans will not be allowed.
- NO OTHER CAMPAIGN MATERIALS MAY BE USED. This includes, but is not limited to: stickers, candy, food, t-shirts, small posters, buttons, Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, SnapChat, or electronic devices of any kind.
- Candidates must conduct a positive campaign based upon their assets and potential contributions to the Student Government Association. Negative, irrelevant campaigning will not be allowed.

Failure to meet these deadlines may result in disqualification of candidates.

Any violation of these campaign rules will result in the candidate's immediate disqualification.
