Halloween

Halloween falls on a Wednesday this year. Your student's teacher will be



communicating with you the plans for the day. Students are welcome to wear costumes to school. We ask that there costume does not include blood and gore, weapons that go with the costume are left at home, and no full masks or full face paint. We want to insure a safe and happy Halloween here at school.

Title 1 Funding

Title 1 dollars is extra funding given to school districts by the state. Each district disperses this funding in different ways. In Mesa County School District 51, title funds have always been given to schools with a free/reduced lunch count higher than 50%. Last year the district changed its formula to qualify schools to 35%. With this change, Shelledy now qualifies for additional Title 1 funding (38%). We have already begun utilizing this funding to improve opportunities for student learning through the purchase of technology, curriculum, instructional coaching and quarterly plan days for teacher professional development. In accordance with state compliance, parents and staff must be given a Parent-School compact. The compact will be sent home in Thursday folders. Please read/sign/and return to school.

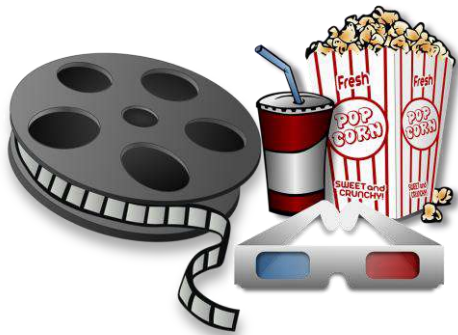
Fundraiser -

Stop Walk Talk

This month Shelledy School Counseling lessons have given students the opportunity to review and practice Stop, Walk, Talk! Stop, Walk, Talk is used to communicate to another student that they are doing something that is problematic, or unwanted. The Stop, Walk, and Talk lessons consist of teaching students to use 3 simple and progressive steps: Telling another student through an “I” message to stop, walking away if the problem continues, and finally talking to an adult if the issue is not resolved.
