

Spanish Honor Society (SHS) at Brookfield High School

Nomination Criteria

1. The student is in the 10th grade or above, currently enrolled in Spanish and has achieved an honor grade (90% or above) in the study of this language in semester 1 of the current year and in the prior year of study.

2. The student has achieved a MINIMUM GPA of 3.75 at the time of nomination.

3. Nomination is made by the student's current Spanish teacher based on the grade criteria above, and the teacher's assessment of how the student demonstrates through his/her character, class engagement and interest that acquiring and applying the Spanish language and culture is a life skill (beyond just an academic subject).

4. Seniors qualifying for the first time will be nominated during the second quarter of their senior year. Upon approval of their application, they will be able to participate in the club as of the first meeting after acceptance.

5. Tenth and eleventh graders qualifying during the current school year will be nominated during the second semester. Upon approval of their application, they will be inducted during the awards ceremony in June, and can start participating in the club as of the first meeting of the following school year.
