



Spanish Honor Society (SHS) at Brookfield High School

Nomination Criteria

1. The nominated student is in the 10th grade or above, currently enrolled in Spanish and has maintained an honor grade in the study of this language for a minimum of three semesters.

2. Honor grade is defined as 90% or above in Spanish in ALL past three semesters before nomination, and a MINIMUM GPA of 3.5 at the time of nomination.

3. Nomination is made by the student's current Spanish teacher based on the grade criteria above, and the teacher's assessment of how the student demonstrates through his/her character, participation and interest how acquiring and applying the Spanish language and culture is a life skill, beyond an academic subject.

4. Seniors qualifying for the first time will be nominated during the second quarter of their senior year. Upon approval of their application, they will be able to participate in the club as of the first meeting after acceptance.

5. Tenth and eleventh graders qualifying during the current school year will be nominated during the second semester. Upon approval of their application, they will be inducted during the awards ceremony in June, and can start participating in the club as of the first meeting of the following school year.
