On May 5, 2010, the NAMM Foundation announced that Simsbury has earned the designation as one of the "Best Communities for Music Education."

NAMM's 11th annual "Best Communities for Music Education" survey acknowledges schools and districts across the United States for their commitment to and support of music education in schools. One hundred seventy-four school districts were determined by the NAMM

The 2010 survey, which spanned January through March, was available to all districts nationwide. Teachers and school district administrators, representing communities across the country, participated in the web-based survey, which was developed and administered by The Institute for Educational Research and Public Service, an affiliate of the University of Kansas. The districts were measured across curricular and programmatic criteria as well as public support of their music programs. Participants answered detailed questions about funding, graduation requirements, music class participation, instruction time, facilities, support for the music program, and other relevant factors in their communities' music education programs.


