Center for Advanced Learning--CAL

CAL offers advanced courses in 5 technology-based fields for Juniors and Seniors:

- Digital Media (Graphic Design & Video)
- Programming & Networking
- Medical/Dental
- Engineering
- Manufacturing



NOTE: Students apply for CAL during the sophomore year.

International Baccalaureate (IB)

IB classes are the most challenging courses offered at GHS for Juniors and Seniors.

IB Program Options:

- Earn a full IB diploma
 - Take 4 years of a World Language
 - Take IB Tests and Earn college credit



• Take one or more IB classes in strong subject area

NOTE: Students can forecast for IB classes during the sophomore year.

General University Requirements

A minimum grade of "C" in core courses

- 4 years of English
- 3 years of Mathematics (including Algebra 2)
- 3 years of Science
- 3 years of Social Studies
- 2 years of the same World Language
- 16 academic credits in core subject areas

• .5 credit in a Visual/Performing Fine Arts class is recommended
