Eligibility for Sports/Activities

- 1.5 GPA for the quarter preceding season
- Must be passing 5 courses (PE does not count toward the 5 courses)
- Fall sports eligibility will be dependent on the 4th quarter of 8th grade year
- Winter sports eligibility is based upon 1st and 2nd quarters.

Eligibility - 5 Class Rule

- OHSAA requires students to be passing (with a D- or higher) 5 classes in a semester
- The 5 Class Rule is in addition to the Hayes GPA requirement.

Drop Policy

- If students drop courses after the first two weeks of the class starting, they will be issued a “W” for dropping the course.
 - Students may only drop a course with a “W” ONE time during their high school career.
 - A “W” does not affect GPA.
- All courses dropped after this option is used, will result in an “F” for the final grade. This will be entered on the transcript and will affect the GPA.
