#### IS IT A SOUP, SALAD OR A SANDWICH?

- **Grade 7:** Write a paragraph of 5-7 sentences.
- **Grade 8:** Write a paragraph of 8 sentences.

Choose a food and argue whether it is a soup, salad, or sandwich. Use reasons and examples to explain your opinion.

#### Steps to follow:

- 1. Start with a clear sentence that states your opinion (e.g., "I believe X is a salad because...").
- 2. Give at least two strong reasons to support your opinion.
- 3. Use details or examples that make sense for your argument.
- 4. Finish with a sentence that sums up your opinion.

#### Level 3 Criteria (Meeting the Standard):

- Clear Opinion: Your paragraph begins with a clear statement of your opinion.
- Strong Reasons: You give at least two reasons that support your opinion.
- Examples/Details: Your examples make sense and connect to your argument.
- Logical Flow: The ideas in your paragraph are organized and easy to follow.
- Proper Length:
  - o Grade 7: 5-7 sentences.
  - Grade 8: 8 sentences.
- Correct Grammar and Spelling: Few to no errors.
