

Naugatuck Valley STEM Inclusive Opportunity Network (NViSION)

Program Description

The NViSION Scholars Program provides students with \$1000-5000/year, as well as extensive student support services that include a summer bridge program to help students succeed in college-level courses.

Requirements: Students must have a minimum high school GPA of 2.5 with noted accomplishments in STEM courses. Students must be a US citizen, permanent resident, national, or refugee. Students must have demonstrated financial need as determined per FAFSA. Potential NViSION Scholars must commit to enrolling full-time at NVCC in a Science, Technology, Engineering or Mathematics degree programs until completion of the degree and/or transfer to a 4-year college or university. Please note: The summer component of this program runs July 20-August 6 Monday-Thursday 9 am – 1:30 pm.

Proof of Citizenship, permanent resident, national or refugee

- o passport, birth certificate, naturalization paperwork or visa documents
- o copy of the green card, a copy of the USCIS approval notice (which means that the change of status has been approved, but the green card itself is still forthcoming), or a copy of the I-551 stamp in the passport (which is similar to the approval notice described above).
