

Sixth Grade Space Camp Field Trip



- Date: May 3rd-8th, 2020 (Sunday-Friday)
- Cost: \$500
- Sign up and payment deadline: December 6, 2019
- Signups require a 3-step process:
 - 1) Payment in full
 - 2) LMS paperwork submitted to your child's math teacher
 - 3) Space Camp registration forms completed online

1) Payment

2 Ways to Pay:

1. Online via LMS website, via “Student Fees Payment Link” (preferred method) or
2. Send in a check for the full amount to child’s math teacher along with the required LMS forms (no cash accepted). Include DL # and phone # on check.

Due to Space Camp policy, payments are non-refundable.

2) LMS Paperwork

- Obtain forms from your child's math teacher or the LMS website.
- Overnight Field Trip Form needs to be signed and notarized.
- Turn all required LMS paperwork to your child's Math teacher by the sign-up deadline, December 6th.
- Note: All forms and payment must be submitted at the same time. **Your child is not signed up until ALL forms and full payment are properly submitted.**

3) Space Camp Registration

AFTER LMS Sign-up is Confirmed:

- Each camper will need to register for Space Camp online and fill out ALL of their required forms (health, medical, etc.)
- Online registration and trainee forms are due March 27, 2020.
- Note: Your child is not registered for Space Camp until all of their required forms are completed online. **They will not allow your child to attend until all of their forms are submitted in full.**

Important Space Camp Policies (PLEASE READ)

- Students will be dropped off AND picked up at Space Camp by the parent.
- Students may not check out of Space Camp and return.
- Parents may be present during check-in and graduation, but will not be able to visit their child during the week.
- All campers will be expected to abide by Space Camp guidelines.
- Trainees decamped due to discipline or behavioral difficulties will be sent home and no refund will be given. Decamped students must return to school or be counted absent.

What to Pack

- Cell phones are allowed at night, but Space Camp leaders may ask your child to place them in a secure locker during the day to enhance their camp experience and to prevent potential loss/theft/damage.
