Grades 9 – 12
Level II Advanced

While the framework standards in regular and advanced classes are the same, students in advanced-level classes will have a different learning experience. There is an expectation that comprehension and proficiency will be more profound. Students will use higher level thinking skills as they explore the content and more abstract thinking will be necessary. Students in advanced classes are often required to complete more work outside of class than in a regular class. Assessments will be more complex and will require that the student make connections and organize thoughts more efficiently. Upon completion of Level II Advanced, a student's proficiency level may range from Novice High to Intermediate Low.
