To Prospective Spartanettes and their parents:

Thank you for your interest in becoming a Spartanette. To ensure that the clinic and tryouts run smoothly, we want to provide you with as much information as possible. Please be sure that you and your daughter are familiar with this document. A parent/dancer meeting will be held Tuesday, March 30 at 5:00 pm in the MBJH auditorium. The clinic is designed to teach the girls the tryout dance. Each girl will be randomly assigned to a tryout group.

Clinic and Tryouts

The schedule for the clinic will be as follows:

Monday April 12th –Girls report to the <u>Competition Gym</u> by 3:15. Girls should begin <u>stretching immediately</u> so that we can begin learning the routine as soon as possible. After a brief introduction and some preliminary business the girls will learn the first section of the dance. *Carpools should pick up at 5:00*.

Tuesday April 13th – Girls report to the Competition Gym by 3:15 and immediately begin stretching. The girls will then learn the second section of the dance. *Carpools should pick up at 5:00.*

Wednesday April 14th – Girls report to the Competition Gym by 3:15 and immediately begin stretching. Information concerning tryouts will be sent home on this day. *Carpools should pick up at 5:00*.

Thursday April 15st – All girls report to the practice gym at 3:15 for tryouts. Family members, friends and dance instructors are **NOT** allowed inside the building. Results will be posted on the *Spartanette Web Page*. Scores of the candidates are confidential. No candidate may see her actual score sheets or the master score sheet.
