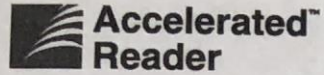
Writing

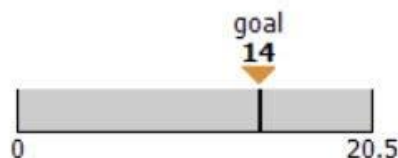

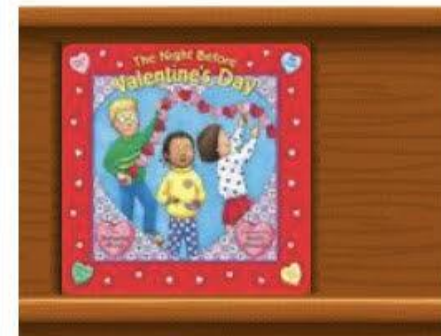
