# **GED® 2014**

This program prepares adult learners to pass the 4-part, computer-based GED<sup>®</sup> exam to earn a State of Connecticut diploma. Students receive necessary instruction in each of four subject areas – Science, Social Studies, and Math and Language Arts. Instructors will also review the official website (GED.com) where students can access related exam information and exam registration procedures. Students must be at least 17 years old and officially withdrawn from school to enroll in the GED<sup>®</sup> preparation. Eligibility for Connecticut GED<sup>®</sup> exam requires students must be at least 17 years old and officially withdrawn from school for 6 months. 17 year olds must submit a withdrawal form with a parent/guardian signature. Individuals who are 18 years of age may submit, in lieu of a withdrawal form, a letter from their last high school that the class with which they entered ninth grade (or would have entered if never enrolled in high school) has already graduated. Students can begin the GED<sup>®</sup> registration process online at GED.com and complete the process in person at Waterbury Adult Education 28 East Clay Street Waterbury CT 06706.


