- 1. Would the District allow for +/- 5 ppm on the B&W MFP device?

 - B. This would also allow us to propose a unit that would exceed all of the specs that are being asked for. le Speed, Stapling, and paper capacity.

Or will the 2 production units be replaced with one of the new smaller B&W or Color units? (Please note the two production units listed on page 3 of the RFP)
