Summary of Siskiyou County



- 5th largest county geographically in state (6,172 square miles)
- Overall, county has seen economic declines
 - Decline of timber & mining has led to gradual economic declines
 - County largely relies on ranching, farming, tourism
- Siskiyou County has approximately 1500 to 2,000 illicit marijuana sites
- Crime, child abuse, drug abuse, alcohol abuse, & related social issues major challenges (17.7% poverty rate)
- Surge of "Green Rush" players have significantly changed landscape
- Illicit drugs equate to "CORE" of crime, social, mental health, economic, and homelessness problems
- Interagency cooperation, collaboration, & proactive strategies are very good (e.g., prevention, enforcement, treatment, etc.)
 - We have three (3) drug task forces (SUMIT, NSMIT, & SIMIT) (DOJ pulling out of SUMIT)
 - SCSO is understaffed & has suffered approximately 30% reductions the last 10 15 years

Siskiyou Interagency Marijuana (Enforcement Team (SIMIT) - 2018

- 21,426 illicit plants seized (\$64,278,000 retail value)
- 14,406 pounds of processed cannabis seized (\$14.4M)
- 140 properties (search warrants) + MN HIDTA "link"
- \$157,368,000.00 total value for processed cannabis
- 19 arrests; 14 cited (78 cases pending)
- 9 pounds of concentrated cannabis seized
- 6 BHO "concentrated cannabis" labs seized
- 7 firearms seized; \$25,222 drug proceeds
- Fire dangers, refuse, pollution, "Quality of Life" "Key"



Siskiyou Interagency Marijuana Investigation Team (SIMIT)



2018

- 21,426 illicit plants seized
 - \$128.5M to \$192.8M (East Coast Retail)
- 14,406 lbs. processed marijuana
 - \$28.8M to \$43.2M (East Coast Retail)
- 140 search warrants + MN "Link"
- 19 arrests, 14 cited (78 cases)
- 9 lbs. of concentrate cannabis seized
- 6 BHO concentrated labs seized
- 7 firearms seized + \$25.2K money
- Fire dangers, refuse, pollution, "quality of life" issues "Key"
- Carbon Monoxide Deaths 3

2019

- 44,369 illicit plants seized
 - \$266.2M to \$399.3 M
- 16,759.5 lbs. processed
 - \$33.5M to \$50.3M
- 154 search warrants
- 9 arrests, 10 cites (70+pending)
- 15 firearms seized
- \$29,596.00 drug currency seized
- Fire dangers, refuse, pollution, "quality of life" issues "Key"
- Carbon Monoxide Deaths 2
- Murder & Mayhem now "Linked"



SCSO "On-Highway" Seizures



2018

- October 5 October 25 (SCSO)
- Six seizures of Illicit marijuana during routine traffic stops
 - 5,183 pounds of illicit marijuana seized
 - \$10.2 millions' worth of illicit drugs
 - Marijuana destined to other states
 - Seizures indicators of massive illicit drug trafficking organization links
 - Detective visit to Minnesota revealed "links" to Siskiyou County product

2019

- Roughly similar time frames
 - 63 illicit plants seized
 - \$378K to \$567K (Retail)
 - 2,074.4 lbs. of processed or partially processed marijuana
 - \$4.2M to \$6.2M (Retail)
 - Seizures again indicative of major DTO activity & links
 - Major on-highway transfers out-of-state
 - "U-Haul Incident" Pursuit & overt effort to harm deputy







- One detective, 1 to 2 "extra help" detectives
- DEA (DCEP \$67,500.00) = flight, Equipment, & O.T.
- HIDTA funding & DEA funds "key" factors
- Asset Forfeiture funds occasionally beneficial
- \$13,564.58 (USFS) = Exhibit B (MOU) (NSMIT)
 - Trends seen dictate private vs. public land grows
- \$5,765.36 for Equip & \$7,799.22 for O.T. \$\$\$
 - Most USFS funds are allocated for NSMIT
- National & Statewide recognition of efforts



North State Major Investigation Team (NSMIT)



2018

- Ops hindered Wildfires
- Gazelle-Callahan Road
 - 5,071 illegal plants
 - 15 active greenhouses
 - Drug cartel suspected
- CAMP-NSMIT Op Humbug,
 - Illegal marijuana + carbofuran
- Siskiyou Co Arkansas Case
 - 80 lbs. cannabis = Follow-Up
 - 20 lbs. marijuana, firearm, ammo

2019

- Focus shift to private lands
- 17,230 illegal plants seized
- 1,044 lbs. of processed
- 8 arrests (3 firearms seized)
- \$103.4M to \$155.0M retail (East Coast) (3-plant yield)
- NSMIT "regional"
- Some "Repeat Offenders"

- \$17,000.00 HIDTA funds provided for overtime

SIMIT & NSMIT TOTALS - 2019



- 61,599 illegal marijuana plants eradicated
- 17,763.5 lbs. of processed marijuana seized
- 18 firearms seized
- Arrests, citations, & pending cases 70+
- Values = \$369,594,000.00 to \$554,391,000,00
 - Marijuana plants (3-plant yield) East Coast Retail
- Values = \$35,527,000.00 to \$53,290,500.00
 - Processed marijuana (East Coast Retail)



Marijuana & "Murder" 2019



- Murder Victim: Hunter Sims, 31, Texas (Feb. 7, 2019)
 - 2nd trip to CA to purchase marijuana (shot in head)
 - Mr. Eddie Dodge, 41, Redding (suspect) Trial started
- Murder Victim: Spencer Hodgson, Klamath, CA
 - From Santa Cruz, owned marijuana business (sold product)
 - Link to marijuana unknown at this time
- Murder Victims: Ms. Rosey Vang, 49, WI & Ms. Mor Hang, 81, Dorris, CA (Double Homicide) at marijuana site (Mar. 20, 2019)
 - Pleasant Valley Estates (Butte Valley); both shot with rifle (Cartel?)
- Attempt Murder "Shots fired" shots fired at wife of suspect (Lee Xeng Yang, 53) 4 kids present at time
- One Sac Co SO murder suspect and MN fugitive captured at site in 2019



Siskiyou Unified Major Investigation Team (SUMIT)



- 399.36 lbs. marijuana (2017) 617.28 lbs. '18
- 279.22 grams concentrated cannabis 2017
- 314.2 grams concentrated cannabis 2018
- 12,412 grams of meth seized 2018
- 10,644.3 grams heroin seized 2018
- 83 firearms seized 2018 (12 in 2017)
- \$435.5K money seized ('17) \$104,985 in 2018
- Murder, mayhem, DTO activity all "linked"


















Assessment

- Marijuana is MAJOR health, justice, environmental, & fiscal threat to county & our citizens (quality of life, H2O, HAZMAT such as carbofuran)
- WE COULD NOT DO JOB WITHOUT DEA DCESP & HIDTA FUNDS!
- Prop 64 is "DISASTER" "Black Market" flooded w/quality, cheap marijuana – HAS PROMPTED MORE ILLEGAL PRODUCT EXPORTED TO U.S.
- Board of Supervisors' decisive actions & "Local State of Emergency" vital
- Some county illicit growers leaving but DTO grows gravitating to private property sites due to CA laws (e.g., Prop 47, Prop 64, SB 54, etc.)
- Children impacted greatly "Availability & Perception of Harm"
- HIDTA "Status" has led to additional support (e.g., DEA funds)
- DEA (DCESP), WSIN, CA DOJ, SUMIT, USA, CARNG, CAMP, CHP, "vital"
- DARE "partnership" with HHS/BHS a big success story
- Public Works & Code Enforcement Actions very IMPORTANT
- Joint ops w/other counties, water boards, & CDFWL a success in 2018
- County getting big "Pay-Offs" for minimum investment







- SIMIT (SCS0) & NSMIT (DOJ-led) needs full support
- More federal, state, & local drug task forces needed
- Increase in DCESP funding vital to continue fight vs. DTOs
- Continue SIMIT, NSMIT, Public Works, & Code Enforcement
- Sustain "State of Emergency" & Moratorium (#1 Stop Illegality)
- Interagency Collaboration a Major "Key" (Local/State/Fed)
- Enforce ordinance provisions (fire, water, sewer, home reg's)
- Still a gap in CDFWL & NCRWCB support Engagement "key"
- Sustain HHS/BHS prevention strategies (DARE) (+ Treatment)
- Use of CARNG, HIDTA, WSIN, DEA, USFS & USA "CRITICAL"
