

Variable Selection

Simple summary: Do not break calculations out by a variable.

One variable: Calculate for each value of one specified variable and the overall total, e.g., a **frequency** report.

Two Variables: Calculate for the values of two variables and the overall totals, e.g., a **crosstab** report.

Three Variables: Three-level hierarchical report, e.g., for each year, all months, and for each month, all days.




