First Comprehensive Plan Survey A Home Run!



Surveys went to every household and business in Willistown and were available to the public online.

- Of 2,216 responses, 92.8% were Willistown property owners
- 45% of all Willistown parcels responded
- 48% of residences responded










45% response rate is very high—typical response rates range from 5-30%

30% of respondent households and businesses, or 668, signed up for Comp Plan updates

20% of respondent households and businesses, or 440, expressed interest in volunteering

TOWNSHIP-WIDE RESULTS

Confidence Level: 99%

The Township can be confident that the responses reflect every resident in Willistown based on the statistics including:

- Rate of Response: 45% of total parcel owners and 48% of resident parcel owners, and
- Distribution of responses in each area

Margin of Error: 2%

Range of 4 points, +2% or -2% on each response.

PLANNING AREA RESULTS


Confidence Level: 95%

Range of 8 points, +4% or -4% on each response.












Respondent Age & Years in Township






