MPR Statistics

Report Background

The Multiple Person Report (MPR) Statistics provides statistics that can assist supervisors and managers in managing the multiple Person Id (PID) remediation process.

Report Purpose

Provides aggregate data on children with possible duplicate Person IDs in CONNECTIONS based on an exact match of the primary name, gender, and date of birth. Children that are part of cases which have been merged into others are not included.

There are reports for:

Statewide, LDSS (A01-A58, A66), and NYC Boroughs (A70-A75)

Borough A72-Manhattan includes Sites:

CBD, CWP, CZP, HCD, MBD, and Entire Borough.

Each report contains line charts and corresponding data for:

Matches within District - Active Individuals

Matches within District – Individuals closed for 2 years or less Matches within District – Individuals closed for more than 2 years

Statewide Matches – Active Individuals

Statewide Matches – Individuals closed for 2 years or less Statewide Matches – Individuals closed for more than 2 years

Active Individuals

Counts only those matches where the "target individual" is in an active stage within the selected district/site. However, the matches to the target individual may be in either closed or open stages.

Individuals Closed Less than 2 years

Counts only those matches where the "target individual" is <u>not</u> in any active cases and its most recent closed stage has been closed for 2 years or less. All matches to the target individual will be in closed stages.

Individuals Closed More than 2 years

Counts only those matches where the "target individual" is involved in stages that have been closed for more than 2 years. All matches to this target individual will be in stages that have been closed for over 2 years.

Notes

Data Warehouse MPR Statistics data may differ from Connections MPR data because of the different data refresh time. The Data Warehouse MPR is scheduled to run every other Sunday at 8:00 a.m. (data as of Saturday).

CONNECTIONS MPR is scheduled to run on the same week - Saturday at $10:00\ p.m.$

Data Item	Data Definition
LDSS (LDSS version)	The name and 3-digit agency code for the Local District selected at the report prompt. This report can be run for only one District at a time.
Borough (NYC version)	The 3-digit NYC county code selected at the report prompt.
Site (NYC version)	The 3-digit Site Code for borough A72 selected at the report prompt.
Scope of Matches	 Matches within District – the target and match are within the same district. Statewide Matches – the target and match may be from any district in the state.
Type of Report	 Active Individuals Individuals closed for 2 years or less Individuals closed for more than 2 years
Reporting Timeframe	The start and end dates selected at the report prompt.
Report Date	The date on which the report was run.
Data as of Date	The latest refresh date of the MPR data. Data for this report is refreshed every two (2) weeks.
Data Refresh Date	The date series on which the MPR data refreshed.
Total Records	Total number of children with possible multiple Person IDs for Statewide/LDSS/Site based on Scope of Matches and Type of Report. • Within District Active • Within District Closed <2 Years • Within District Closed >2 Years • Statewide Active • Statewide Closed <2 Years • Statewide Closed <2 Years • Statewide Closed >2 Years
Total Target Individuals	Total number of target individuals for Statewide/LDSS/Site based on Scope of Matches and Type of Report. • Within District Active • Within District Closed <2 Years • Within District Closed >2 Years • Statewide Active • Statewide Closed <2 Years • Statewide Closed <2 Years * An individual (PID) is defined as being in a case jurisdiction based upon their involvement in a case in that case jurisdiction. That would be the 'target individual' and all matches to that individual would follow it on the report.

Total Match Number Change	The difference between one refresh date total match individuals and the previous refresh date total match individuals.
