Please include the following: A completed form, a separate check for each course made payable to **Treasurer, town of Wallingford**, a self-addressed stamped envelope for return receipt.
2. **DROP-OFF IN PERSON.** Come to the Rec. Center and drop off your registration form with payment check in the marked REGISTRATION MAILBOX.
3. **DROP OFF AFTER BUSINESS HOURS:** Business hours are Monday – Friday 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. A postbox is conveniently located in the main lobby for you to drop in your registration. This will be processed the next business day.

TERMS & CONDITIONS:

1. Parents and Guardians of children enrolled in the after school arts program are required to provide information of persons authorized to pick up the child. **The student will not be released to any persons other than those on the list.**
2. **Children are to be picked up from the art room. Authorized persons are required to sign out the child at the time of pick up.** No child will be allowed outside the building unescorted.
3. The **pick up time is 4:50 sharp.** The teachers have to go on to their next class so it is important to pick up the child on time. Do not delay pick up time.
4. Upon enrollment parents are required to send in a **note to the child's teacher** requesting that the child be **dismissed to the art room as a walker** on the day of the class.
5. Students are expected to follow school rules. ***Disobedience, destruction of school property and any behavioral problems*** may result in the student being expelled from the program.
