Tentative travel plans: Leave Mill Creek at 8:00 a.m. on Monday, May 11 and travel by school bus to Camp McDowell near Jasper, AL (Parents must arrange to bring their child and his/her luggage and bedding to school that morning. Bus drivers are not permitted to bring camp luggage on regular bus routes). Students will return to Mill Creek by school bus around 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, May 13.

To register for camp there are four things that must be completed and returned:

- 1. Field Trip Permission Slip
- 2. Waiver Liability and Risk Form
- 3) NOTARIZED Out of County/Overnight form. If you complete one for the Chattanooga Aquarium trip, you will not need to do this again.
- 4) A \$25.00 registration deposit.
- 5) Health Form: complete front and back. This does not have to be completed by a doctor. If your child is on medication, a specific form is required and will be given out at a later date.

Students will be on the camper list when ALL forms are turned in with your registration deposit.

<u>Please do not turn them in separately as it complicates record keeping</u>. You may keep the cover letter and the packing list.

<u>School dress codes and behavior rules apply while at Camp McDowell</u>. Please note that students with behavior issues <u>will not be allowed to attend camp</u>. This is at the discretion of the faculty of Mill Creek Elementary, but no students with a history of ISS or suspensions will be allowed to attend.

I, the undersigned, understand and agree that participating in any Program inherently involves risks, hazards, and dangers, including but not limited to the risks of falling, falling rocks or objects, fractures, concussions, dangerous weather, overexertion, overheating, injuries caused by a lack of fitness or conditioning, river currents, hypothermia, hostile or aggressive farm animals or wildlife, equipment failures, negligence of others, accident, injury, death, mental or emotional trauma, disability, and property damage or loss.
