

STUDENT MEAL ACCOUNTS

Homewood City Schools will establish procedures to ensure that students receive a healthy lunch each day. Payment is expected to the Student Meal Account when the meal is received. This can be done by establishing an online prepayment account or paying at the point-of-sale. It is the responsibility of the parent or guardian to keep sufficient funds available in the Student Meal Account. When payment is not presented or available from a pre-paid account, one reimbursable meal per day will be served to the student. Students without payment may not charge a la carte items or additional portions.

Upon graduation, funds remaining in a Student Meal Account will be returned upon written request no later than June 15 of the year of graduation. Funds not requested by June 15 will be forfeited to the Child Nutrition Program.

The Superintendent will establish a procedure to address on-going negative balances within the Child Nutrition Program.
