



Click Studies Weekly in Classlink.



Type in your username and password.

Your username is your school email, and if you do not know your password, you can click the forgot password link on the sign in screen.

*(To make sure Classlink holds your login information, right click the Studies Weekly app in Classlink and choose*


*Update Password. Click Edit and be sure you have entered your correct username and password and submit to save.)*

Teachers will be able to edit their classes and students starting today. They might have to log out and back in for the change to apply.

- Teachers now have the ability to manually edit their classes.

- All of the existing data will stay the same.

- Teachers are able to add or remove classes and students whenever needed.

- This change allows existing teachers and students to work uninterrupted, but would also allow teachers who wish to make changes to do so.

Teacher logins can be obtained by the teacher by visiting the website and clicking the forgot password link. There is no management part of this program. Each teacher manages his/her own class & students.
