The Naco Elementary School District is located in rural southern Arizona and serves the Naco community. This lightly populated community sits on rolling hills at an elevation of 4,610 feet and is sheltered by mountain peaks that reach up to 7,500 feet. Temperatures are moderate compared to Arizona's low desert region. The region records an average of 284 days of sunshine each year. An average of 16" inches of rainfall occurs during the years. Sierra Vista, 33 miles to the southeast is the region's major shopping area.

District Profile

Naco Elementary School District No. 25 is comprised of one K-8 school with an average student population of 300. Naco students feed into Bisbee High School. The school facility is a modern structure with classrooms and supporting space. The facility has a library/media center that also houses a computer lab. A multipurpose room that includes a league regulation gymnasium, a performing arts wing, a full-service kitchen, and an administrative office also support the education program.

The Naco School community places a high value on academic achievement for all students. The Board and staff place a high value on a curriculum that is rigorous, innovative and well-rounded while always remaining responsive to the student's needs. Small class sizes allow teachers to give one-on-one support to each child.
