Cold Reading	Enthusiasm, looks up at other, reads well, understands the text	Some enthusiasm, looks up from page three times	Lacks enthusiasm, looks up less than three times	Lacks reading and understanding skills, does not look up from text	
Projection	Performer can easily be heard across the room, without shouting or sounding strident.	Performer can be heard across the room but is shouting or sounding strident.	Performer speaks at regular conversational level rather than in stage voice.	Performer is barely audible.
