Troupes & Companies



Rotella offers intensive courses called "Troupes" where students are exposed to the techniques of all art forms including dance, drama, TV/media, visual art, handbells, vocal music, and stagecraft and offer courses called "Companies" where students are still exposed to all art forms but do not have to audition. Companies are arts integration based lessons focused on a specific art form. Click here to view our course catalog.

All 4th and 5th grade students at Rotella participate in the Troupes and Companies program. Students choose their favorite art form and either audition to be part of the performance based Troupe program or they choose to participate in the arts integration focused companies that students do not have to audition for. After auditions all students are placed in either a troupe or a company. Once a week for 45 minutes, the students transition to the location of their troupe or company and participate in the activity or rehearsal.

At the end of the year there is a Troupe Show where the performance based troupes perform for the school. Companies are welcome to perform if they choose.

The TV/Media troupe works in Rotella's TV studio creating news broadcasts featuring various topics.
