



Items you need:




toilet paper roll (empty) or empty food can

decorations (of your choice)


- 1. Tape one end of your paper roll shut with paper.
- 2. Add beans or rice (no more than ½ full).
- 3. Tape the remaining end of the tube shut.
- 4. Make sure your taped ends are secure, then test your shaker.
- 5. Finish by decorating with crayons, markers, etc...




Fishy Visual Arts
