



## High School Prospectus

**WHAT:** The Festival of the Arts celebrates student achievement in the visual arts. This year we will celebrate student achievements and talents virtually.

**HOW:** Students or teachers will photograph the student's artwork. Teachers will submit the photo and student information online. There will be three submission sections: High School, Academy/Middle School and Elementary School. The submissions will be put together into video presentations and posted on a CNUSD site as well as on CNUSD communication platforms.

### IMPORTANT DATES FOR THE 2022 FESTIVAL:

- Online Entries of Artwork: Monday, March 21st - Friday April 15th
- Video Release Date: May 4th

**ELIGIBILITY:** CNUSD high school students (grades 9-12) enrolled in an art class during the 2021-2022 school year.

- Each art teacher may enter up to 10 student artworks.
- Each student may exhibit only **ONE** artwork for the entire show, regardless of having more than one art teacher.
- Artwork must be initiated and completed during the 2021-2022 school year.

**CATEGORIES:** Each 2022 entry must assign to one of the following categories. Select categories based upon the actual work and not course titles.

**Drawing and Painting:** graphite; black pen and ink; charcoal, colored pencil; colored pen and ink; oil or chalk pastel; watercolor pencil, watercolor on paper; tempera on board or paper, acrylic or oil paint on canvas, board, or paper, and 2D mixed media

**Graphic Design** - artwork created using Photoshop and/or Illustrator, such as digital illustrations, surrealistic designs, paintings done in Photoshop, digital collages, etc. in which the student did not originate the photographic foundation/content, designs such as logos, fonts, book covers, posters, packaging, invitations, album covers, magazine covers, etc.

**Digital Photography:** straight digital image shot in-camera with no major post-processing. Color correction, cropping, black and white conversions, and basic retouching allowed; Original, student-initiated, digital image with edits that incorporate digital processing (i.e. Photoshop) to create an altered image, such as a composite or any added element that was not present with initial image production.

**3D Design** - ceramics Utilitarian/sculpture -functional glazed and fired piece, decorative glazed and fired pieces, work viewed in the round, non-utilitarian, open medium, single medium or 3D mixed media.
