#### WHY IB?

- According to a June, 2018 article in Forbes Magazine:
- The four-year completion rate for college students was just 28% - which means nearly 2 million students will drop out before earning a diploma.
- Only about 26% of full-time, first-time students in Community college complete their degree within three years.
- In fact, the U.S. has the highest college dropout rate in the industrial world, according to the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development.

#### Why the high drop out rate?

#1 Cost

#### **#2** Lack of Preparation

- Students drop out of college because they simply aren't ready to be there
- A disturbingly high number aren't prepared academically or emotionally (stress)
- Close to half of U.S. high school graduates do not complete a college-nor career ready course of study




