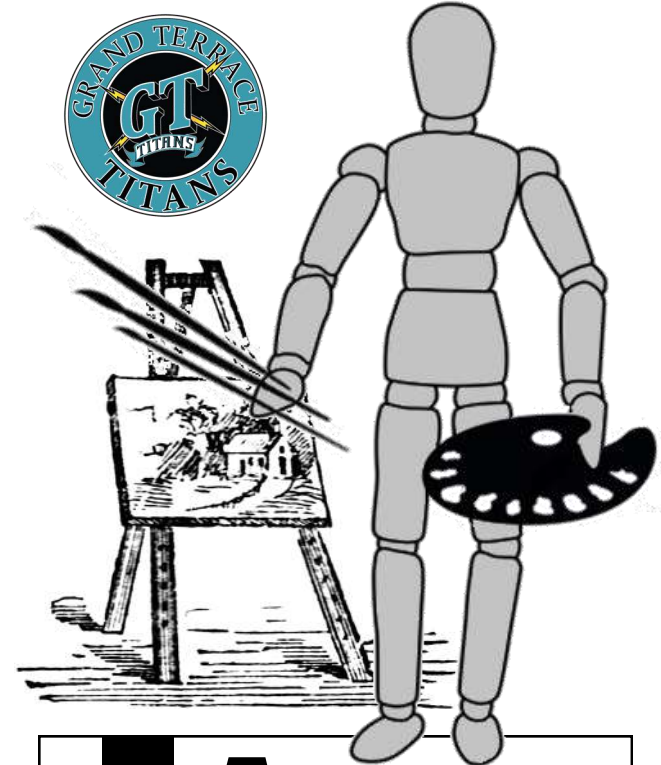

Academy students are expected to commit to the four-year pathway track focusing their studies in visual arts. The program places an emphasis on standards-based instruction while using the arts as a vehicle for helping students develop a sociological perspective that will allow them to gain a better understanding of themselves, as creative individuals, and the world around them.
