EARLY ACTION

If SPU is one of your top choices, definitely apply early (by November 1). Early Action gives you priority status throughout the admission process.

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- Application** — You can apply through the **SPU Application** or the **Common Application**.
- \$50 application fee**
- Essay** — You'll submit this with your application. *This is where we get to meet you. Be creative — but, even more importantly, be authentic.*
- Test scores** — We accept either SAT or ACT scores directly from the agency (this can take two to four weeks), or scores can be listed on your official transcript. *SPU's test codes: SAT-4694, ACT-4476. We superscore the SAT.*
- Official high school transcript** — Your high school counselor can upload your official transcript to the Common Application, or mail your official transcript in a sealed envelope directly to our office. You can forward a sealed transcript to us as well, as long as you receive it from your high school.
- Optional** — Interviews and letters of recommendation.
