IB RECOGNITION

DO COLLEGES REALLY CARE?

UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA

- 30 quarter units toward undergraduate degree for an IB scores of 30+ points

- 8 quarter units for scores of 5 or higher on designated HL exams

- Earned credits may allow students to register for classes earlier, satisfy GE requirements, and graduate sooner



COLLEGES KNOW FORMER DP STUDENTS ARE MORE LIKELY

- TO ATTEND AND PERSIST IN A FOUR YEAR COLLEGE AFTER TWO YEARS TIME

- TO EASILY ADJUST TO COLLEGE COURSEWORK AND RESEARCH

- TO ATTEND A 'SELECTIVE' OR 'HIGHLY SELECTIVE' INSTITUTION COMPARED TO THE AVERAGE US COLLEGE-GOER

EXAMPLES OF IB RECRUITMENT

Drew University - \$25-15K annual scholarship to students who earn certain grade averages in their high school's most rigorous college prep programs (IB)

University of Rochester - \$15K annual IB Scholarship available as acknowledgement of the hard work and determination

Western Oregon University - IB Diploma recipients with a score of 30+ receive both Guaranteed Admission and the Provost's Achievement Scholarship, a renewable four-year award of \$2,500 per year

Worcester Polytechnic Institute - Select IB graduates with an exam score of 40+ receive a minimum of a \$20,000 merit scholarship
