VOCATIONAL EDUCATION

- Educational experience that combine Academics
 & Career Technical learning.
- Career Technical Education (CTE) focus on growth over time – Introductory to Mastery of Skills.
- CTE Curriculum is guided by DESE competencies in each of our shop areas.
- The curriculum is continuously updated, and our teachers remain current on the latest technology and requirements in each field.



EXPLORATORY PROCESS

The introduction and exploration of several career pathways through immersion into the program area.

7 Exploratory Cycles

- Top 3 choices, 1 Non-traditional, 3 addition from top 10
- Schedule is designed from your FamilyID registration
- Schedule is given during Freshmen Orientation

Non-Traditional Shops

- All students are assigned one non-traditional shop
- Non-traditional shops are determined by DESE

Exploratory Orientation

Each Friday prior to "shop week" for 45 minutes



EXPLORATORY PROCESS

- Uniform and Dress Codes for Exploratory
 - Exploratory T- Shirt
 - One Complimentary Shirt will be ordered for you
 - How to order additional shirts, link to be sent via email
 - Jeans/Work Pants
 - Safety glasses
 - One set of Safety Glasses provided annually
 - Replacement glasses are \$2.00
 - Closed toed shoes
 - Do not invest in footwear until a shop is assigned
- Exploratory Cycle Reflections
 - During Career Enrichment class

Grading Rubric

- Skill Development (Competency in technical area)
- Employability (Follows instructions)
- Workmanship (Quality of work)
- Workplace Readiness (Safety)
- Professionalism (Behavior)

Grades will be posted to iPass each week



SELECTION AND PLACEMENT

- Decide Survey is conducted (rank 1,2,3...)
- Students are placed according to their score in the selected program
- If a program fills, students will be placed in another program (choices 2-7)
- The overall average during exploratory may impact program placement, it is used as a tie-breaker



SELECTION AND PLACEMENT CONTINUED

- Career night (November)
- Decide activity
- Initial placement (December)
- Extended exploratory (January & February)
- Wait list period
- Round 2 placement (March)
- Student Survey (April)
- Round 3 placement (May & June)
- Program switch deadline is T1 Sophomore Yr.


