

**SCHOOL DISTRICT OF PLATTEVILLE
NOTIFICATION OF VOCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES
(SECTION 204(G) OF THE CARL B. PERKINS VOCATIONAL EDUCATION ACT)**

Each year, the School District of Platteville offers vocational education programs at Platteville High School. These programs are designed to prepare youth for a broad range of employment and training services and are offered under the guidance of certified teachers, counselors, and cooperative education coordinators.

Platteville Schools offer vocational programs in agriculture education, business and marketing education, family and consumer science education, and technology education.

Specific courses in agriculture and natural resources are: Agriculture Business and Leadership, Agriculture Cooperative Work Experience, Animal Science, Exploring Natural Resources, Food Science, Horticulture and Plant Design, Introduction to Agriculture and Leadership, Plant and Soil Science, and Veterinary Science.

Specific courses in business and marketing include: Accounting I, Accounting II, Business and Personal Law, Business Cooperative Work Experience Program, Computer Literacy and Applications I, Computer Literacy and Applications II, Entrepreneurship, Hillmen Outlets School-Based Enterprise, Introduction to Marketing and Entertainment, Marketing Cooperative Work Experience Program, Personal Finance, and Sports and Entertainment Marketing.

Specific courses in family and consumer sciences include: Baking I, Baking II, and Cooking Outside the Box.

Specific courses in technology and engineering include: Advanced Manufacturing, Construction Technology I, Construction Technology II, Construction Technology III, Construction Technology IV, Introduction to Engineering Design, Energy, Power and Transportation, Explorations in Manufacturing and Construction, Multimedia Communication, Photography, Principles of Engineering, Production Graphics, Welding and Fabrication, Woodworking and Design I, and Woodworking and Design II.

The following is a list of work experience programs being offered this year and their criteria for admission:
