



#### The Last Day of School Activities

Exciting activities are planned for our last day of school on May 21st. Classroom teachers will communicate with families the specific plans for their classes. The school wide End of the Year Slide Show will be shown virtually in classrooms. Students will be released for the day and school year at 2:00 p.m.

Spring is a time for "Spring Cleaning" and it is no different at Orchard Avenue Elementary. Here are some things that we need your help with as we prepare for the end of the school year:

#### **Lost and Found**

Our Lost and Found has lots of clothing and lunch box items that we would love to return. Jackets, sweatshirts, hats, gloves, and lunch boxes were discarded and



abandoned on the playground. Please take a moment to check the lost and found bin before and reclaim missing items before school is over. For your convenience we will place the bin in the foyer There is also a nice assortment of smaller items (such as glasses, jewelry, keys, and cell phones) that will need to be claimed in the office. Any unclaimed items will be donated to charity or destroyed

after the last day of school.

#### **Student Medications**

If your child takes a prescribed medication or over the counter medications that you have supplied to the school, please stop by the health office to pick it up by 3:00 p.m., Friday, May 21st. This is a firm date. Any medications left after the last day of school are destroyed.

Medications will not be sent home with the child – they must be picked up by an adult.

#### **Student Address Changes**

The final report card of the year will be mailed to your home. *If you have moved over the course of the school year, please contact the office to make sure we have your current address on record*. Also, if you know your child(ren) will not be returning to Orchard Avenue, kindly let the school office know so we can factor that information in our planning for classrooms next school year.

It's hard to believe that the end of the school year is only a few weeks away! We have some exciting things happening this month as we prepare to finish the year strong.

- PTA is hosting a Spring Picnic on May 7 from 5:30 7:30. There will be games and activities as well as a food truck.
- We will have "in person" student-led conferences on Friday, May 14 (classroom teachers will be in touch to schedule a time).
