6:43 PM Motion to approve the Treasurer's Report: 1st- Becki Wyzycski 2nd- Deb Fargo

6:45 PM Motion to approve May 2021 minutes: 1st- Becki Wyzycski 2nd- Angela McVeigh

6:46 PM Scholastic Book Fair: Liz Rhoads noted that there were about 100 families that came to the Book Fair over the two days. \$125 was donated from families. Ms. Beahan was able to buy books for the libraries and for fourth grade students that were reading titles from a specific author. Ms. Beahan couldn't be here tonight but wanted to thank the families who donated money.

6:47 PM Fundraisers: Mr. Bordeau noted that there hasn't been any guidance yet for next year as far as in-person events and fundraisers. Lindsay Gladue said that PTO can make a tentative calendar for next year. Mr. Bordeau agreed. Great Silva said that the Boy Scouts did really well on an Ice Melt Fundraiser in the winter. Ashley McKinney noted that a gift card fundraiser could be really profitable. PTO could also have ongoing Spirit Wear for sale during the school year. She also said to think about more ideas for fundraisers over the summer. Angela suggested that PTO gives one free spirit stick to Pre-K and K students next year since most won't know what they are. Ashley M. brought up the idea of having the Book Fair set up during the day at school for students to be able to shop. Liz R. mentioned that she asked Ms. Beahan about having the book fair set up in the Library two years ago, but unfortunately there isn't enough space. However, she asked Mr. Bordeau about the possibility of setting up the Book Fair on the stage in the future. He said that is something that could work if there were cases only, no tables set up.

6:56 PM Review and Approve Next Year's Budget: PTO members discussed what the Student Match program is. Mr. Bordeau explained that it was a program designed for high school students to be able to mentor elementary students and this is something that he would like to implement again in the near future. The monies from this fund would support things like fun treats. Angela said that she got rid of the "Drama" line item, as that program has been gone for a while. The Yearbook Advisor stipend was raised from \$1500 to \$1600 this year.

7:00 PM The only change was for the Sunshine fund to be raised to \$300/ year from \$150/ year. 1st- Becki Wyzycski 2nd- Sabrina Stockmeyer.

7:05 PM Principal Comments: Mr. Bordeau noted several important items. Field Day shirts came in. Board of Ed. approved new playground equipment and it has been ordered. The equipment would be installed first and then the new wood chips would be installed after. In the last eighteen months, the athletic fields have been used by the students more in order for social distancing to be maintained. Installation of the new equipment could be done with the help of the maintenance staff and volunteers. The new equipment would consist of a drum apparatus, a chime, a four piece walking area, and an A frame tent. Ultimately, the new playground area would be dedicated in Mrs. Allard's remembrance. End of year activities include fourth grade's celebration this Friday, and a two- day Field Day next week during exploratory times. Hopefully next year, we can go back to doing bounce houses and dunk tanks. Lastly, Mr. Bordeau expressed his thankfulness for everything that the PTO does.

7:15 PM Final Thoughts: Jenna Motta noted that the staff was very thankful for everything the PTO did for Staff appreciation week. Lindsay concluded that the Amazon wish list donations from families was what really helped.
