Dear Parent/Guardian:

Griswold Public Schools has the opportunity to receive \$500,000 in grant funding – but we need your help! In order to receive this grant, we must show that at least 10% of our parents work on federal property – including Mohegan Sun Casino, Foxwoods Casino, all active military bases and federal properties, and Electric Boat in some instances. We are confident that we meet this requirement, but must have a form filled out for each student with a parent/guardian who worked on federal property as of February 12, 2020.

How you can help:

Complete and return this survey to your child's school by Wednesday, February 26th, In order to qualify for grant funds, we must have a completed, signed and dated form for each student (one for each sibling). The form is split into three sections.

Section I - Demographics: This is to collect general information about your child(ren).

Section II – Other Federal Properties: This should be completed by parents/guardian who are employed by a casino, any Federal branch (VA, Federal Reserve, etc.) or worked for a private contractor on federal property such as the Sub Base (i.e. The Commissary).

<u>Please note</u>: Commissioned submarines docked at Electric Boat are also considered federal property. If you worked on a commissioned submarine this year, please list the hull number and name of the submarine.

Section III – Active Military Members: This section should be completed by parents/guardians who are Active Duty in any of the Uniformed Services. Please include Active Duty member's name, Branch of Service (USN, Coast Guard, Army, Air Force, National Guard, Marines), rank or grade and station or unit.

Any information provided will be held in the strictest privacy, being made available only to authorized representatives of the United States Department of Education for verification purposes. Please contact my office with any questions.



We are redrafting the entire League Baseball and Softball. All players age 7-12 must attend tryouts.

2020 Tryout Information - GRISWOLD HIGH SCHOOL

JCLL is a skills based league when placing players in each division. All players age 7-12 must attend tryouts. The following are the exception:

- If your child is league age 6 (August 31, 2013) and has played 1 year of T-Ball, they may try out for Farm System. Any League Age 6 player not attending tryouts will be placed in T-Ball for the 2020 season.
- WE ARE HAVING A REDRAFT FOR ALL BASEBALL AND SOFTBALL
- * Your child will be drafted and placed on a league team based on both their age and their skill level. Fallure to attend tryouts jeopardizes a player's placement on a team. [Little League Rule Book IV (f)] If you have any questions, please contact VP of League Division.

- * JCLL is a non-profit organization and is run by volunteers. We rely on volunteers to run all the league operations, and this season we will be using JCLL volunteers to assist with the concession stand and a few Opening Day activities.

There is a \$25 concession stand volunteer fee per family. This is in addition to the registration fee.

Two (2) hours of volunteer time in the concession stand is required per family for those that wish
to receive fee back at end of season.

Note: There are only a few volunteer opportunities available on Opening Day. Sign up is first come, first served basis. JCLL will publish a sign up roster through sign up genius.

* Payments and registration forms not received online by February 27, 2020 will be considered late, and will be assessed the posted "Late Registration Fee" stated above. All registrations received after March 7, 2020 will be placed on a wait list.
