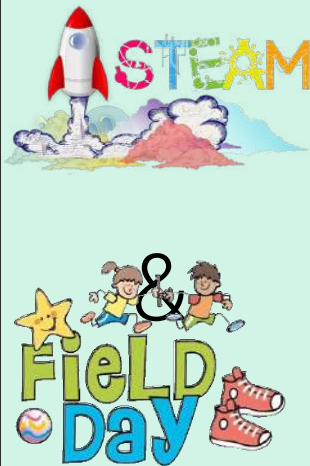


Interim Learning Opportunities
