# **Tolland High DECA students win first round of the Be Entrepreneurial Challenge**

Tolland High School DECA students - *Abhay Kohli, Sam Nussbaum, Jude Reagan, and Cal Soucy* recently won top honors in the first round of the Be Entrepreneurial Challenge. Organized by the Junior Achievement of Southwest New England and Bentley University, this one-day intensive seminar focuses on teaching students about the mindset and the skills needed for success as aspiring entrepreneurs and innovators. Working with volunteer business mentors, area high school teams used Design Thinking, a problem-solving approach, to create concise, effective, and actionable business plans. The day culminated with the students pitching their business plans to a team of judges who assessed the teams on the elements of starting a business that were highlighted throughout the day.
