Daily Schedule – Morning Arrival	
	Only traditional students will report to campus beginning Monday, September 14 th . Virtual students, those who are
	completing courses on Edgenuity, will continue working online at home.
	The bell schedule is posted on the school website.
	CAR RIDER DROP OFF - Morning student drop off is no earlier than 7:10 a.m. CST. Parents drop off is in the track/softball field parking lot across from the school. Students must walk through the tunnel under the road. After exiting the tunnel, students proceed between the two building and into the school's courtyard.
	BUS RIDERS - Buses will begin their routes at 6:00 a.m. CST. Please be at your bus stop at 6:00 a.m. CST for the first few days of classes. Two buses pass each residence. One bus goes to an elementary school and one bus goes to the Jr High/High School. Bus drivers will stop at each student to ask if they are going to an elementary school or Junior High/High school. 7 th grade students will not be riding the same bus as they did last year. Students will be assigned seats on the bus. After the 1 st few days you will have a better exact time when the bus will be at your house. Students should write down their bus numbers when they get on the bus. This will be the same bus they will go home one in the afternoon. The tardy bell for all students for 1 st period is at 7:35 a.m. CST
	Where to report – Students will report to the lunchroom for breakfast or to their 1 st nine weeks, 1 st period class each
	morning. Room numbers can be found on student schedules in INow/Chalkable. Room numbers correspond with building numbers. For example, room 504 is in building 5, room 610 is in building 6 and room 1008 is in building 10.
	Students should either have a copy of their schedule with them or a picture of their schedules on their cell phone. During the
	first week of school students may use their cell phones to look at their schedules on their phone between classes.

	Communicate with school officials if COVID related symptoms or exposure occurs
	Students, visitors, and staff must wear masks at all times while on campus or on a school bus.
	Measures to utilize social distancing will be taken as much as possible.
	All halls will be 1 way traffic – students will enter from one end of the building and exit through the opposite end. An umbrella is recommended at all times for change of class.
	7 th grade students will change classes 5 minutes prior to 8 th grade class change to minimize hall traffic
	Restrooms will be regularly sanitized and capacity limited
	Meals will be grab and go from the lunchroom and taken back to the classroom. Breakfast and lunch will be provided for all students at no cost until January.
	No food/lunch deliveries will be accepted.
	Seating will be social distanced to the extent possible. Students will have assigned seats in all classes.
	Students will need to ensure that they bring all supplies needed for class to prevent sharing.
	Students who have been issued Lee County Chromebooks should bring those devices with them each day, fully charged.
	Until the remaining Chromebooks for students arrive, it is recommended that when possible students bring a personal device (phone, tablet, laptop, etc.) to use
	Drinking fountains will not be functional during the current conditions. There are water bottle fillers in building6, building 10 and the cafeteria. Please bring your own water bottle for reuse.
	Afternoon Dismissal
	7 th grade dismissal is at 2:55 CST. 8 th grade will be dismissed at 3:00 CST.
	Students are only allowed to ride their bus home. Bus notes to ride the bus home with another students will not be accepted.
