NOTICE OF APPRENTICESHIP OPPORTUNITY

FOR THE POSITION OF INSIDE WIREMAN (ELECTRICIAN) APPRENTICE – ACCEPTING ON AVERAGE 10 APPRENTICES PER YEAR

The Western Colorado Electrical JATC is accepting applications for the Inside Wireman Apprenticeship program. Applications are available every Wednesday at 4 to 5 p.m. at our Training Center, 3210 E Road, Clifton, CO 81520 or by appointment. Call for more details at (970) 242-3432 Ext 5.

To meet minimum qualifications for apprenticeship, applicants must:

- a. Complete an application form.
- b. Be a minimum of 18 years of age. Documented proof required.
- c. Proof of residency. (lease, utility bill, cable/phone bill)
- d. Provide an official transcript for high school and post high school education and training. All GED records must be submitted if applicable.
- e. Show evidence of successful completion of: one full credit of high school algebra, or one post high school algebra course, or the NJATC Math Course.
- f. Obtain a qualifying score using the electrical industry's aptitude test developed and validated by the American Institutes for Research. At time of aptitude test, there is an application fee of \$45.00.
- g. Possess a valid Driver's License.
- h. Individuals who can verify (proper documentation required) that they have worked a minimum of two-thousand (2000) hours specifically in the electrical construction industry will qualify for an oral interview by meeting the requirements of items (a.), (b.) and (e.).
- i. Honorably discharged veterans and individuals with previous electrical work and/or training experience may also qualify. For details, contact the JATC.
- j. Be available to work and have reliable transportation to anywhere in the following counties: Delta, Dolores, Garfield, Gunnison, Hinsdale, La Plata, Mesa, Moffat, Montezuma, Montrose, Ouray, Pitkin, Rio Blanco, Routt, San Juan, San Miguel.

Applicants who meet all basic requirements will be interviewed by the JATC. Apprentices will be selected in order of their final ranking.

The recruitment, selection, employment and training of apprentices during their apprenticeship, shall be without discrimination because of race, color, religion, national origin, or sex (including pregnancy and gender identity), sexual orientation, age (40 or older), disability and genetic information. The applicant must meet the minimum age requirement. The JATC does not, and will not, discriminate against a qualified individual with a disability because of the disability of such individual. The sponsor will take affirmative action to provide equal opportunity in apprenticeship and will operate the apprenticeship program as required under applicable law and lawful regulations issued thereunder.
